


Explore Skopje by foot with the Skopje City Walk



If you are new to Skopje, or you have more guests than you can handle, Skopje City Walk will be your personal paper guide. Exploring Skopje by foot has never been easier.

Skopje City Walk is the only available booklet in Skopje to explore the city on your own. It offers two walks, one through stara carsija and the other one through the modern part of the city center. The walks are shown on a map, and the text will also tell you where to go. There is lots of information about the sights you will encounter on your way. This way, you will learn about the sights you see, without getting lost or missing interesting things.

Skopje City Walk is created by Sanne and Linda from The Netherlands. They both have a Macedonian husband and already live in Skopje for a while. They both freelance for the Dutch market, but felt like they wanted a colleague in their working life. When they decided to start a project together, a city walk was the one out of seven ideas that they selected to begin with: "This idea sprouted in November 2012, was selected in January 2013, printed in July 2013, on the shelves in August 2013 and in the newspaper and on TV in October 2013".

The brochure has been received with appraisal from both Macedonians and foreigners alike. That's why Sanne and Linda decided to create a second edition for coming tourist season: "With the project Skopje 2014 continuously changing the city, we felt that a new version is in order". The new brochure will be published in May. Besides that, the ladies have many more goals. Behind the scenes, they are building a professional website, they are working on an app and they are writing an Ohrid City Walk: "Making an app is quite tricky, so we hope that it will work out. But if we manage that, we can easily provide many more walks, like Ohrid, Debar Maalo or Bitola".

Sanne and Linda see a bright future for the Skopje City Walk: "Our goal is that people who visit Skopje, immediately think of Skopje City Walk when they want to explore the city. Not just tourists, but also business men. Not just in summer, but also in winter. Not only that, we would like that people who live in Skopje immediately think of Skopje City Walk when they get visitors who would like to explore the city on their own."

You can buy Skopje City Walk in the souvenir kiosks in the city center, at Majka Teresa memorial, at Porta Makedonija, in bookshop Kultura, at souvenir shop Despe Design in stara carsija, in the Museum of the Macedonian Struggle and in the Museum of Makedonija.
